Individuals or couples willing to open up their home have the opportunity to make an incredible difference in the life of a child. As a **Full Time Foster Care Provider** you will provide a caring, safe and structured environment with fun activities and dependable routines. **Part Time Relief Providers** offer support and care 1-2 times per month. This commitment involves the inclusion of the child in your regular family life.

Experience with youth or young children with developmental disabilities and FASD would be ideal. Knowledge of First Nations culture and some related post-secondary education would be an asset. Child must have a private room, be in a non-smoking environment, and play in a fenced yard. There are current placement opportunities for qualified candidates with no young children or pets in their home. Driver's license and transportation are required.

Full time Foster Care Providers receive a (tax free) monthly remuneration and Relief Providers are paid per days worked. *Parkland CLASS provides extensive training which all Foster Care Providers are required to take.*
