PARKLAND CLASS RELAUNCH STRATEGY



Parkland CLASS' Relaunch strategy is based on a gradual return to 'normal' activities while still maintaining a level of caution to ensure the health & safety of individuals, staff and families. Factors contributing to the plan include but are not limited to:

- Individual vaccination rates,
- Provincial restrictions and guidelines, and
- Individualized Risk Assessments

PCLASS PHASE 1 (June 1 - 30)

Immediately (Date): Based on Individual Risk

- Outdoor activities will be permitted (picnic, walks with friends, parks, drive through's, etc)
- Face shields do not need to be worn while outside
- Outdoor gatherings are limited to one additional cohort (1 person other than yourself)
- Family visits are permitted outdoors and/or offsite, but the visitor(s) must be of the same cohort.
- Proprietors camping with the family unit is permitted as long as remaining within your cohort.
- Playgrounds & splash parks permitted as long as distancing is maintained.

PCLASS PHASE 2 (July 1-31)

TBA: Based on Individual Risk & Vaccination Rate

- Gowns are not required unless the home is following isolation protocols due to symptomatic individuals or close contact risk.
- Shields are not required unless the home is following isolation protocols due to symptomatic individuals or close contact risk.
- *Note: Staff may still choose to wear shields, goggles or gowns at their own discretion.
- Masks are still required in the home.
- Masks may still be required in community (ie. Health Care facilities and private businesses)
- Individuals are permitted to attend indoor activities and events (ie. restaurants, swimming) while being mindful to limit exposure to large groups or gatherings. (no specialized risk tolerance required)

Indoor Visits are permitted by designated visitors. Visits must be in individuals room where possible. Screening must still occur. Only one individuals visit at a time. (Risk Tolerance form required)

- All COVID cleaning protocols remain in place
- Training will continue to be offered virtually where possible, but some classes may be held in person.
- A gradual return to full Community Bridging hours will be started.
- Daily screening and symptom checks are still required.
- Proprietor Relief opened up (must be discussed with Coordinator prior to using)
