Our agency is currently looking for a full-time Licensed Practical Nurse at the Charlotte Vehus group home in Inuvik, NWT. As an LPN you will monitor, report on and assist with the daily living needs of 8 individuals with developmental disabilities and encourage them to live as independently as possible. Your duties will include providing a caring and supportive living environment, as well as administration of medical treatments & medications, providing assistance with bathing, personal hygiene, toileting support, cooking, feeding, light house cleaning, and writing notes. Participating in fun activities in the community and developing friendly relationships with the individuals is important. Also, you will be providing directions to residential aides.

Driver's license would also be an asset but is not required.

A job offer is contingent upon a satisfactory police information check and successful LPN Registration in the NWT.

Pay Rate: \$39.59 per hour plus \$7.00 per hour Northern Allowance. Moving expenses reimbursement and travel allowance to be discussed at interview.

Parkland CLASS is looking for casuals who are available short notice to fill a variety of shifts including days, evenings, weekends and overnights. We are looking for staff that are willing to support individuals with developmental disabilities. This position will be trained in the proper use of PPE and will be required to provide direct support to individuals that are in isolation pending the results of COVID tests or who have tested positive for COVID if we have positive cases.

As a Casual Residential Aide you will assist individuals with their daily living needs and encourage them to live as independently as possible within their home and community. Your duties will include providing a caring and supportive living environment, following behavior support plans, as well as providing assistance with bathing, personal hygiene, toileting support, administering medications, cooking, feeding, light house cleaning, and writing notes. Participating in fun activities in the community and developing friendly relationships with the individuals is important us.

Parkland CLASS employees provide hands on training and mentorship to assist staff in developing the skills required for success within the position. Please note on your resume if you have any experience caring for individuals with special needs. Knowledge of Inuvialuit and Gwich'in culture, or related experience caring for children or family members would be an asset. Any post-secondary education related to the Human Services industry would be an asset. Valid driver's license would also be an asset but is not required.
